

## Weather Report

The weather in the Baltic Sea region will be determined by a low area over southern Sweden which is slowly moving northwards during the next two days.

Southeasterly to easterly winds are drifting the ice away from the eastern coast of the central Baltic Sea towards the Swedish coast.

Within our operating area, particularly the region between the Swedish south coast and the German and Polish coast is concerned.

The Kiel Canal passage meanwhile takes about 10 hours. Tug boats and icebreakers are being utilized to enable the closing of the locks.

In various affected regions convoying is under implementation in order to safeguard a smooth passage in and out of the ports.

All crews are instructed to take any effort to stick to the schedule as close as possible. Due to the hard winter conditions you may rest assured that vessels can be delayed.

Nevertheless, please be reassured that Team Lines will do its utmost to offer a reliable service.
