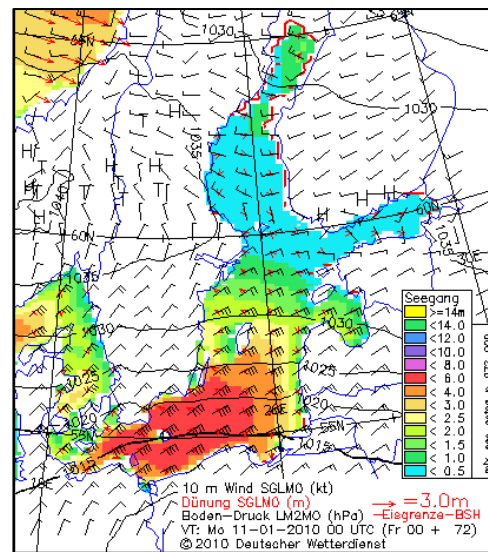
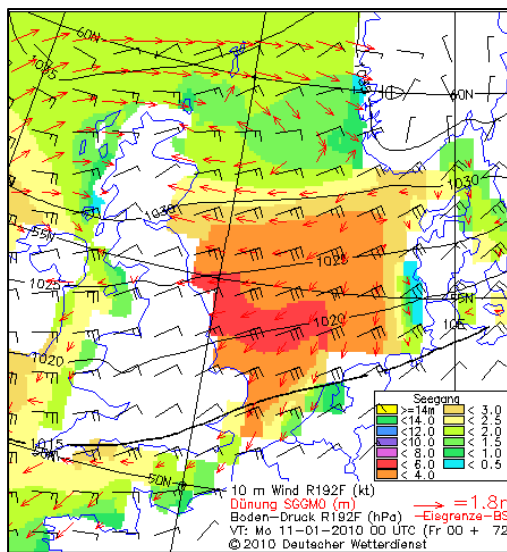


Weather Report

Dear Customers,

The low pressure front “Daisy” is currently dominating weather conditions in large parts of the European continent. Especially, for the upcoming weekend we are expecting **stormy sea in huge parts of the Baltics**. Gale force winds and heavy sea are going to last until the beginning of next week in the Southern and Western part of the Baltic Sea. Within our operating area, particularly the region between the Swedish South Coast and the German and Polish Coast is concerned.



Furthermore, increasing ice formations throughout the Gulf of Finland are expected within the next days. Please take particular note of the following vessels and services where delays are to be anticipated:

M/V Elisabeth (SWE 2):	ETS HAM 09.01.2010
M/V Beluga Sensation (POL 2):	ETS HAM 09.01.2010
M/V Tongan:	ETS HAM 10.01.2010

Besides harsh weather conditions at sea also difficulties in terminal operations have to be taken into account due to icy temperatures and frost. Alike we refer to the ports of Åhus, Gdansk, Gdynia and Norrköping.

All possible measures are being taken to cope with the current ice situation. Ice breakers are mobilized to ensure smooth passage through the fairways in the best possible way. All crews are instructed to take any effort to stick to the schedule as close as possible.
