Dear Customers,

Please be kindly updated that the ice situation in the Baltic Sea remains rather stable for the time being. A low pressure area over the Southwestern part of the Baltics even follows in a slight decrease of ice layers.

On the contrary, in the Eastern Baltic regions a high pressure area supports the formation of some additional ice within the Bay of Bothnia as well as the Gulf of Finland and Riga.

However, in all regions concerned, ice breakers are in service. Only considering St. Petersburg, there are currently four ice breakers on duty in order to keep the fairways clear.

Fortunately, none of our vessels is expected to encounter any delays so far. In case the ice situation has any further impact on vessels and schedules, we will send an immediate update.
