

**Weather Report 02/12**

Dear Customer,

Please find below our weather report / forecast for the next 24 and 48 hours:

After the predicted storm from last weekend, a new storm front is rapidly approaching our area of trade. As in the previous case, this front is expected to hit with its full strength within 48 hours with the trough of the low pressure system that will reach the north-sea within 24 hours.

Services that are likely to be affected by the described weather conditions are the following:  
NOR 1 (Tina) / NOR 2 (Elisabeth) / FIN 1 (Reinbek) / NOR 3 (Katharina B)

As the picture of the Baltic shows s/w-ly gale force winds and swell of 5 – 6 meter are expected in arnd 48 hrs time thus the port of Klaipeda may again bear the brunt of the storm.

The picture of the north-sea shows the trough near the center of the system with n/w-ly near-gale up to gale force winds and swell of 6 – 8 meters in the german bight and fischer. It is likely that the water will be pushed into the port of Bremerhaven possibly delaying berthing etc.

All going well the system will move on a north-easterly course leaving our area of trade around Monday. Anyhow the next front is rolling up with expected landfall around Tuesday / Wednesday next week.

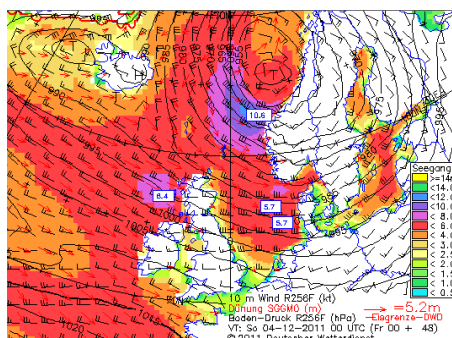
