



Weather Report

Dear Customers,

currently we are facing tough weather conditions caused by frost and ice occurring in some parts of our operating area. Please find below our weather report and forecast for the next 72 hours which might influence the b.m. services:

- M/V Spica (BAL1): close ice, the fairways are still ice-free - on schedule
- M/V El Toro (POL1): close ice, on the fairways are still ice-free – on schedule
- M/V A La Marine and M/V Navi Baltic (FIN1): thin fast ice, new ice and ice formation – on schedule

Expected Ice Development

The next three to four days intensive ice formations are expected.

Gulf of Finland 1 (HEL, KTK) – Gulf of Finland 2 (TLL) – Finland Westcoast (TKU, RAU)

The low pressure region over Finland is continuing to fill up slowly, leading to moderate frost with south-westerly winds over the Gulf of Finland.

Southern Baltic – Latvia – Swedish Eastcoast

In the more southern Baltic Region continuously light frost. The ice in sheltered regions will continue to increase.

Gulf of Finland 3 (STP)

Very close, compact or consolidated ice. Three ice breakers in service.

All crews are instructed to take any effort to stick to the schedule as close as possible. However, hard winter conditions are likely to enforce delayed operations. In case the current schedule is affected, you will receive an instant update from our side.

Nevertheless, please be reassured that TEAM LINES will do its utmost to offer a reliable service also during the icy season.
