Weather Report / Vessel Update

Dear Customers,

As already expected last week, the low pressure front "Daisy" heavily influenced the weather situation in Europe. Gale force winds were dominating the Southern parts of the Baltic Sea. Consequently, concerned vessels were only able to operate at very low speed causing namable delays. Furthermore, due to frost and snow storm, several terminals were forced to limit their operations.

Please take particular note of the following vessels and services which were delayed as a result of the current weather situation:
